

Questions and Answers from March 20, 2017 Conference Call

1. Under 8.0 (1)(H)(ii), Proposer must submit “a copy of either (i) a California seller’s permit issued under Revenue and Taxation Code section 6066 et seq. or (ii) a certificate of registration issued under Revenue and Taxation Code section 6226.”

The seller’s permit is required by Public Contract Code § 10295.1. This requirement remains in the RFP.

2. Under 8.0 (1)(F)(viii)(c) “It is mandatory that all employees, volunteers, and subcontractors are fingerprinted and undergo security clearance by LiveScan or any other security clearance provider agreeable to the Court. Proof of the security clearance must be provided to the Court to ensure the security of the data that is being processed by the service provider.”

8.0 (1)(F)(viii)(c) will be amended to read: *“Proposer will demonstrate ability to adhere to commonly accepted industry standards to ensure security of the data that is being processed by the service provider.”*
